Cheshire Custody Centre

THE TASK

The project consists of three new purpose-built Custody Centres to provide centralised custody services for the County of Cheshire. The commission includes the operation of the Centres for the period of the concession and also the provision of transportation services related to the arrest and processing of detainees.

The consortium team, known for the purposes of the project as Cheshire Custodial Services (CCS), consists primarily of GSL Global (previously known as Group 4) as the bid leader and prospective operational services provider, TPS providing architectural and civil/structural engineering design, and Alfred McAlpine who are the building contractor.

The project is only the second PFI Project in the UK involving purpose built new Custody Centres, and comprehensive operational and transportation services.
