



## Glasgow Science Centre

TPS was commissioned by Carillion Building in Scotland to provide a site based architectural Design Manager/Co-ordinator for the development of the new Scottish National Science and Exhibition Centre on the banks of the River Clyde, opposite the SECC in Glasgow.

Architects BDP designed three very complex buildings. The first a 100m high revolving tower, the second a three dimensional cinema and the third an impressive exhibition centre. The organic forms ensured that the sub-contractors' detailed design process required the most co-ordinated approach.

Iain Sime of TPS, a Senior Technician with over 30 years experience, added all his knowledge to the process of developing the three buildings in close liaison with the Main Contractor, Carillion's site based team.

The building envelope is a combination of high tech titanium cladding and glass in forms that have never been used in Scotland to date.
