

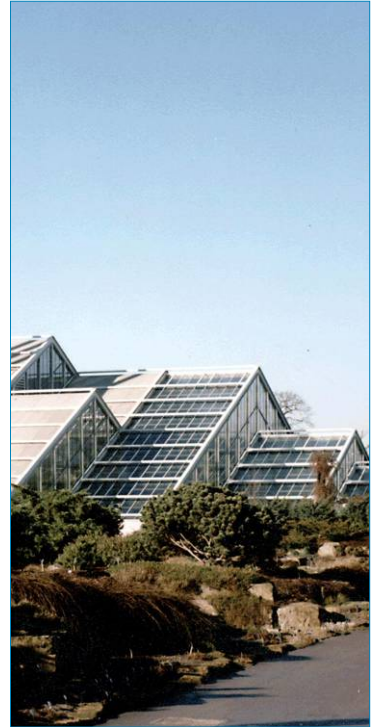


Princess of Wales Conservatory, Kew Gardens

The Princess of Wales Conservatory at Kew is the world's most advanced, energy-conscious public conservatory, with a unique computer-controlled environmental system: ten different tropical and sub-tropical habitats have been created under single roof.

The award-winning Conservatory, which receives over one million visitors each year, is a dramatic stepped arrangement of traditional greenhouse forms on a historically sensitive site, and contrasts superbly with the more static forms of the older glasshouses at Kew.
