



Olympic Site Media Hub, Stratford, London

Schal are providing CDM-C services as part of a multi-disciplinary team working on the design and construction of the Media Hub that forms part of the Olympic site.

The Olympic site consists of many buildings of various style and functionality, some of which are designed for legacy and short term use. Some structures will be dismantled once the games are completed. The site was originally a mixture of industrial, commercial, and residential properties, intertwined with canals, rivers and underground structures.

The various structures that form the Media Hub project are;

- IBC (International Broadcasting Building)
- MPC (Main Press Centre)
- MSCP (Multi Storey Car Park, including transport mall for buses)
- MPCR (Main Press Conference Room)
- Catering Village
- High Street retail units and associated facilities
- Temporary extension to MPC offices at 1st floor level
- Bridge Links from MSCP to IBC/MPC and from MPCR to IBC/MPC
- Satellite Park
- External Works including access ways, services and landscaping.

A standard of consistency for the CDM role and requirements for handover documentation has been drawn up by the ODA that Schal complies with, and applies to all structures across the entire Olympic park .

HSE has appointed an Inspector specifically overseeing the Olympic Games site to ensure that exemplary health and safety standards are of the highest quality.

The opening date for the Olympic Games clearly leaves no leeway for extension, so the need for the design and construction stages to progress without delay is a major driving force throughout the project.
