

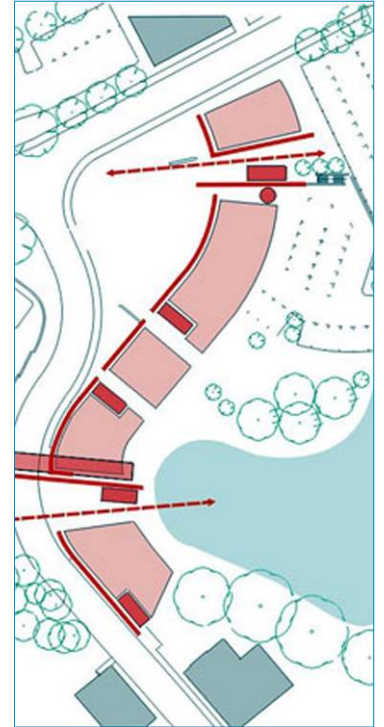
Royal Holloway University - campus master planning

We were involved in the design of several new buildings for the Royal Holloway University's campus, at Egham. Working within the confines of existing buildings, we made a concerted effort to ensure that the additional building enhance the existing urban fabric, for the benefit of all users, reinforcing and landscaping existing court like enclosures and extending the campus to create further public spaces

The buildings, conceived as a unified whole, accommodate laboratory, teaching and office space for the Information Security Centre, and an extension to the existing Student Union Building, linked via a glazed bridge and focused upon a new garden court and pond.

The projects have also been designed with low energy consumption in mind and boast a range of energy saving design features, including a cooling system that uses night air to cool the building's concrete structure and moveable sun screens that prevent unwanted solar gain during the day.
