



# Great Western Hospital Treatment Centre

## THE TASK

Following the successful delivery of the Great Western Hospital at Swindon, Carillion was awarded the contract to design, construct, commission, operate and maintain a new £29m treatment centre at the hospital.

The Treatment Centre provides 108 NHS beds and 20 private patient beds. The NHS beds are split between three 36-bed wards, an orthopaedic ward, a surgical ward, and a multi specialty ward. Additional facilities within the NHS areas of the building include restaurant facilities, pre-assessment clinic rooms, five theatres (four laminar flow), a 16-bed theatre recovery area, and offices for clinical staff. Attached to the Private Patient wing are dedicated consulting rooms.

The additional clinical capacity supported by the treatment centre is around 5,500 additional in-patients, predominantly in the specialties of trauma, orthopaedics, general surgery, urology and ear, nose and throat.

The methods, materials and construction team remained consistent to enable continuity in the new facility and to best capture the excellent work undertaken on the original scheme. In addition to this Carillion worked in close partnership with the Trust to develop any lessons learned during operation of the Great Western Hospital.
