



Tulliallan Police Training College – Refurbishment

THE TASK:

The Scottish Police College commenced training in 1954 following a decision that officers from all Scottish Forces should be trained centrally. The College is located in the centre of Scotland, situated in about 90 acres of parkland. At the heart of the campus is Tulliallan Castle, built in the early 19th Century.

The facilities at the College have been periodically extended over the years to meet the changing nature of Police training and the demands of the Forces for student places. The College currently provides approximately 75% of all Police and Support Staff training, with the other 25% being carried out by individual Forces.

THE DESIGN:

TPS was recognised as having the design and with Schal the management skills to overcome the conflicting demands of time and quality and mould the SPC requirements into a viable project. TPS was commissioned to project manage and redesign the senior staff accommodation and the function rooms within the Castle and complete the project within 10 weeks.

Senior staff accommodation needed to have the flexibility to be used by visiting VIP guests from around the world. The brief required welcoming, comfortable surroundings where visitors and long term users alike would feel at home in the wonderful surroundings of the castle and its grounds.

On a more regular basis the rooms would be providing long term living accommodation for the staff, many of whom would be occupying them for up to 2 years.

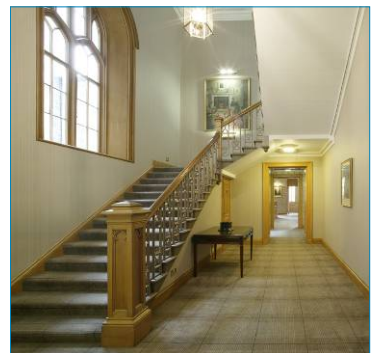
THE SERVICE:
